- Provide a broad, balanced and relevant curriculum, which makes learning exciting and reflects and celebrates the diversity of our community;
- Provide high quality and modern resources (including ICT equipment) for all subjects to support teaching and learning;
- Encourage all children and adults to respect and take care of other people and their surroundings;
- Promote high standards of work and behaviour, providing clear guidelines and systems to ensure children know what behaviour is expected; including the 'stay on green' system (see school's behaviour policy);
- Provide regular opportunities for you to meet teachers to discuss your child's progress and a comprehensive annual report;
- Set regular homework / home learning which enhances the school curriculum, encouraging children to apply and extend their learning. Home learning will be explained in the curriculum letter each term for years 1-6 and will include reading at home each day;
- Be welcoming and open, listen and respond to your suggestions or concerns;
- Provide guidance on how you can support learning at home and offer a range of opportunities for you to become involved in the life of the school;
- Take a positive role in the local community, building partnerships to enhance and enrich children's learning;
- Ensure that the equal opportunities policy and complaints procedure are available at all times on request;
